Qualification

PhD or M.Sc. in Env Engg./ Env. Science/Management

Experience

10 years' experience in a University, an agency involved in environmental policy formulation, management and regulation, or as a consultant for candidate holding PhD and 15 years similar experience in case of candidate with M.Sc.

Work on a similar position on at least two projects of similar nature with proven success

At least 5 papers in peer-reviewed first tier international journal on related subject as principal author or 5 reports in a relevant subject.

Remuneration
