Subject: **MANDATORY USE OF QR-CODED CONFISCATION BOOKS FOR SINGLE-USE PLASTIC CONFISCATION**


**EXECUTIVE ORDER**

In continuation of the Executive Order No. 26/PA-DG/EPA/109/2024 dated 29.03.2024 regarding mandatory E-Inspections through the Eco-Watch App, it is hereby ordered that henceforth all seizure and confiscation actions in respect of banned single-use plastics shall be carried out exclusively through the Eco-Watch App using the QR-coded confiscation books issued by EPA Head Office.

2. Any seizure or confiscation not carried out through the prescribed digital system or without the use of the prescribed QR-Coded confiscation books shall be illegal, void, and liable to disciplinary and legal action.

3. This order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain in force until modified or withdrawn.
