MULTAN ROAD, LAHORE IN COMPLIANCE OF ORDERS OF HON'BLE
PUNJAB ENVIRONMENTAL TRIBUNAL, LAHORE**

In compliance with the orders of the Hon'ble Punjab Environmental Tribunal, Lahore passed in **Civil Miscellaneous No. 21 of 2025 in Appeal No. 584 of 2025 (M/s Berger Paints Lahore versus Environmental Protection Agency through Director General)** and the application received in this office on 30.12.2025 from the Senior Development Manager (Administration), M/s Berger Paints Pakistan (Pvt.) Ltd., 28-KM Multan Road, Lahore, **provisional de-sealing of two (02) burners** strictly for the purpose of conducting air emission testing through an approved laboratory is hereby allowed with the condition that during the period of provisional de-sealing, the said burners shall be operated only for testing purposes and shall not be used for any commercial or production activity under any circumstances.

The said testing shall be completed by 02.01.2026 (Friday), 4.00 p.m
